We are very pleased to be able to invite you in person to see the Year 3 Nativity performance of 'I'm Going To Shine'.

Wednesday 15 December 9am

To support current safety measures, **one adult per child** will be able to attend the performance. We understand that this may be disappointing, so we will be **recording the performance and will share a recorded link with you** all after the event to enjoy. Further details on our access and signing-in process to follow.

Please be aware that these **arrangements are subject to change**, based on local/government advice.

Please be assured that we will endeavour to maintain appropriate safety measures by asking you to adhere to the following:

- Wearing a face mask whilst on school grounds
- Sanitising your hands on entry and exit to the school

In line with our Covid Risk Assessment, we shall:

- Make face masks available, where necessary
- Have sanitising stations available
- Keep occupied spaces well ventilated

Current government guidance states that if you have been in contact with any individual with Covid symptoms or a positive case, you must not attend site unless:

- you are fully vaccinated
- you are below the age of 18 years, 6 months
- you have taken part in, or are currently part of, an approved Covid-19 vaccine trial
- you are not able to be vaccinated for medical reasons.

Your child has already been given a copy of their part for the play and the song sheets to practise at home. Also included, was a suggestion of the sort of costume your child may wish to wear. We would be grateful if you were able to provide your child with a suitable costume for their role.

Please ensure that the class teacher has received this costume in a named carrier bag **on Friday 10 December**. Please do not send costumes to school before this date as, with so many costumes, storage is not possible. Please be assured that bought costumes are not necessary; homemade costumes, blankets and tea-towels are also just as suitable! If you have any difficulty in providing a costume for your child, please contact your child's teacher as soon as possible and we will be able to support.

If you are unsure of your child's part or have any other queries, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.

We are really looking forward to sharing the children's hard work and enthusiasm with you all.
