Learning outside of the classroom 2022-23

Thank you to everyone who took part in the consultation in Term 5 of last school year, with overwhelming support, we are pleased to share how we will develop our wide-ranging and inspiring curriculum further this school year.

Year 6 will be learning outside the classroom on these occasions:

- In week 6 of Term 2 (Friday 9 December 2022), to enhance children's understanding of their science learning: Evolution and Inheritance, we will be visiting The Natural History Museum in London. Teachers will take children around the museum to consolidate learning from earlier in the term and to introduce our history learning: Stone Age to Iron Age. The cost of this trip is £15.50.
- In week 2 of Term 3, children will have the opportunity to build shelters to enhance their history learning during a local visit to Troopers Hill, and experience how ancient civilisations lived. This will aid children to write an instructional guide on how to build a Stone Age shelter.
- In Term 5 Monday 15 May 2023, we will be taking children to the Life Skills centre in Bristol via coach to support children to take personal responsibility for their own safety; assess risks and cope with difficult situations by taking part in realistic and interactive activities. Life Skills fund children in receipt of pupil premium, therefore the cost varies. The cost of this trip is: £16
- In week 2 of Term 6, the children will experience a virtual reality tour of the Ancient Egyptian pyramids to enhance their history learning.

Payment will also be considered as permission for your child to attend the trips.

Any specific detail for individual trips e.g., spending money or alterations to school day timings will be sent out in advance with class reminders posted on Dojo.

Children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding will automatically be provided with a school packed lunch if the trip is over lunch time. Please make us aware if you do not wish a school packed lunch to be provided.
