Reporting a positive case during Easter half term

At Summerhill Academy we want to do everything we can to reduce the risk of any family having to self-isolate during the February half term. We continue to follow the risk assessment and rigorously adhere to the **Hands**, **Face**, **Space** controls.

You can also reduce the risk of your household having to self-isolate by:

- adhering to the Hands, Face, Space controls when out in the community
- being extra vigilant in spotting the symptoms of COVID and following self-isolation rules until receiving a negative test result.

As a reminder:

The three symptoms are:

- high temperature
- a new continuous cough
- loss of smell/taste

If anyone in the household has one or more of these symptoms they **must**:

- stay home (do not attend school or work)
- get a test.

Everyone in the home **must** stay home until the test result is received.

- If the test is **positive** then:
 - report positive test results to the school immediately;
 - your child must stay home for the length of time instructed on the test (usually 10 days), and
 - > all other members of the household **must** also self-isolate (for **10 days**).

Reporting a positive case

It is important that we continue to trace close contacts of anyone who has a positive test result and were in school 48 hours before the symptoms started. From Friday 2 April please report a positive test result by email to Positive.Results@clf.uk or by telephone on 0117 370 4626 extension 1103. The CLF Health and Safety team will monitor the above email and answer machine daily between Tuesday 6 April and Friday 16 April.

Please leave the following information:

- Your Name
- Your child's name



- The Academy they attend
- Date of first symptoms
- The date of the test
- The date of the positive result

If you have had a test and the result has not come back after 48 hours please also report this using the email and telephone number above. These accounts will be monitored by the CLF Health and Safety team who will alert us so that we can do the contact tracing and communication with families of those children needing to self-isolate.

To support you to know if you need to report a positive result please see the table below.

| Symptoms started on | They were in school on | Report |

| Friday 2 April | Wednesday 31 March | Yes |
| Saturday 3 April | Thursday 1 April | Yes |
